FairLife School Ambassadors

The FairLife charity is giving up to four children at each school the chance to become School Ambassadors for the charity.

As a School Ambassador you can:

1. Help to raise awareness of the FairLife charity in your school and surrounding area.
E.g. Present the charity to your teacher or Head Teacher and ask them to consider becoming a FairLife School. Ask the school's PTA for ideas to raise awareness, put up a poster, run a competition, or think of fun ideas to teach children about money.
2. Design posters, adverts, competitions and fun ideas that we can add to the FairLife charity's website for other Ambassadors to use.
3. Join with other children in encouraging national groups to get involved and to help educate children about money.
